<p>Occupational Health &amp; Men's Health</p> <p><b>Karen Woolf - TriEx</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• 600-900 people die from work related diseases</li><li>• 80% are men</li><li>• 50% from cancer</li><li>• 10 x number who die from work related trauma / injury</li><li>• 30,000 work related health conditions</li></ul> <p><b>Worksafe's 10 years strategic plan for work related health (2016 – 2026)</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Carcinogens, including airborne contaminants and hazardous substances</li><li>2. Noise at work</li><li>3. Psychological risks, including work-related stress</li><li>4. Musculoskeletal risks, including manual handling</li><li>5. <p>Drugs at the Workplace</p> <p>Constable Donald Allan - NZ Police</p>	<p><b>Short term effects of Meth/P</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Increased activity</li> <li>• Extreme rush of pleasure</li> <li>• Heightened senses</li> <li>• Sleeplessness</li> <li>• Decreased appetite</li> <li>• Irrational thought patterns</li> <li>• Distorted emotions</li> <li>• Increased heart rate</li> </ul> <p><b>Long term effects of Meth/P</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Chronic insomnia</li> <li>• Weight loss</li> <li>• Repetitive behaviour</li> <li>• Paranoia</li> <li>• Hallucinations</li> <li>• Inability to cope/ depression</li> <li>• Altered personality</li> <li>• Anti-social tendencies</li> </ul> <p><b>Possible signs of P/ drug use</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Loss of productivity</li> <li>• More absenteeism</li> <li>• Workplace injuries</li> <li>• Mood swings / distress</li> <li>• Poor concentration</li> <li>• Unreliable</li> <li>• Increased error rates</li> <li>• Less work</li> <li>• Poor work quality</li> <li>• Financial problem</li> <li>• Mental health issues</li> <li>• Poor nutrition</li> <li>• Sleeping on the job</li> <li>• Lateness</li> <li>• AWOL</li> <li>• And etc..</li> </ul>
