Course Description

This course enables businesses to manage their health and safety risks as required by New Zealand Health and Safety Regulations.

Using ISO 31000 as a guide, participants will examine both the external and internal drivers of risk that impact their company's ability to meet its objectives. Participants will look at the key principles of risk management and relevant key terms.

Participants will evaluate and identify opportunities to improve a company's risk management framework, including improving a company's commitment to workers and contractor's performance.

Participants will learn about the requirements of current New Zealand Regulations and WorkSafe New Zealand guidelines. This will include both a case study and participants own experiences to create a formal risk management process that applies specifically to the participant's business.

Participants will also review some of the common risk management methodologies in use to determine the best one to use for specific situations.
